## + Which picture shows a bay?






### + Bay



A bay is a body of water that is partly enclosed by land (and is usually smaller than a gulf). Canal





## + Which picture shows a canal?







#### + Canal



An artificial waterway constructed to allow the passage of boats or ships inland or to convey water for irrigation.

## + Canyon



A canyon is a deep valley with very steep sides - often carved from the Earth by a river. Delta

## \*Delta

A delta is a low, watery land formed at the mouth of a river. It is formed from the silt, sand and small rocks that flow downstream in the river and are deposited in the delta.
A delta is often (but not always) shaped like a triangle.

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The area near a river's mouth where the river deposits large amounts of sand and silt. Desert




#### + Desert





### + Drought




A period of little rainfall in which growing crops becomes difficult. Gulf




# + Irrigation

A mountain is a very tall high, natural place on Earth - higher than a hill.


#### OR

• A mountain is a natural elevation of the earth's surface rising to a summit, and attaining an altitude greater than that of a hill, usually greater than 2000 feet. Peninsula





# + Which picture shows a peninsula?




#### + Peninsula

A peninsula is a body of land that is surrounded by water on three sides.

#### OR

• A body of land that is connected to a larger landmass and surrounded on three sides by water. Plain






# + Which picture shows a plain?



#### + Plain

Plains are flat lands that have only small changes in elevation. Plateau

#### + Plateau

A plateau is a large, flat area of land that is higher than the surrounding land.

River






# + Which picture shows a river?

• A river is a large, flowing body of water that usually empties into a sea or ocean.

A sea is a large body of salty water that is often connected to an ocean. A sea may be partly or completely surrounded by land. Silt





### + Silt

# + Which picture shows a strait?






#### + Strait

### + Which picture shows a tributary?








• A tributary is a stream or river that flows into a larger river.
